

## Earthquake Affected Schools Linking Project (EASL)

Background: The schools were adversely affected by the devastating earthquake hit on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2015 and then 12<sup>th</sup> May 2015 again. Because of which schools infrastructure became even vulnerable for the children. Though the Temporary Learning Centre (TLCs) were build in required schools with support of different sectors schools are still need of support which not prioritized by the others. In such condition the schools felt a relief by the small support by the link schools from UK.

The schools under the EASL project from Nepal are Triratna Cooperative School, Shree Chunidevi LSS, Shree Chandidevi PS and Ganesh School.

According to the schools request and keeping the concern of the need of the schools, the schools were supported in different sectors. The detail description of the use of the EASL fund is stated below.

### *1. Triratna Cooperative School*

The school's old building was totally damaged by the earthquake so the school was shifted to new place constructing Semi Permanent Classrooms. On the mean time, according to the schools request Gan Centre has supported in making cushion of UKG (Upper Kindergarten).

As per the request of Madhukar Tuladhar, Head teacher from Triratna Cooperative SS the school observation was carried out dated on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2016, while observing the school's physical infrastructure the school's TLCs are found to be destroyed by the storm blew on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2016. Class 4 and 5 were used to conduct in the destroyed classrooms before. Since the new session is starting soon, the classes are needed to reconstruct soon.

### *Income Genrating Project in Triratna School*

Furthermore the school was supporting in the income generating project for making the school as learning hub for both parents and students. The school will generate income on the other hand. The school is running a home stay and they want to consume the produced vegetables from the land themselves. The agriculture activities are just started in the school by planting the mix vegetables, and they will update about it after interval of time with their planning for the future.



### *2. EASL School 2: Chandi Devi PS, Dukuchhap*

The School constructed TLC with two classes but the floor was very rough due to no plastering. After the requisition of the Head teacher and SMC, the school was supported in getting the classrooms plastered.

The school had ECD rooms but was reconstructed since it got damaged by the earthquake. But school was in difficult due to no budget for making furcating in the rooms. But it was necessary to do for safety of the small child from coldness. Thus according to the school's request, the school was supported in making the furcating for those classes.

### *3. Collection of rain water project in Shree Chunidevi Shikshya Mandir LSS*

Shree Chunidevi Shikshya Mandir LSS is the school situated at Bungmati- 08 in Bungmati Lalitpur. The school was established by the initiation of local people in 2017. The school was started as primary and after gradual development its running till grade 8 at present. There are 120 students reading presently in this school. The school is funded from government and supported from the community. The poor background students are reading in the school. Since school is receiving limited fund from government for teachers' salary, scholarship and books to students but it is not able to improve all its physical needs. The school is facing the problem of scarcity of water.



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The school is situated at the hill top and because of which the water problems are facing severely by the school. Even more there is no any regular water supply in the tap. Though little amount of water is collected in tank that is not sufficient for students to keep hygiene at school. Thus school has two tanks of 5000 liters capacity to collect rain water but no infrastructure is there in newly constructed two rooms. Thus it is requested to support us in pipe fitting and constructing gutter in new buildings too.

If the rain water collection system is constructed in the school the problem of scarcity of water to use by students and teachers would be controlled at least 6 a years.

- ✍ The students will get enough water to wash hands before and after toilet.
- ✍ There will be proper facility of the drinking water for the students and teachers in the school.
- ✍ The compulsion of buying water from tank with high amount will be resolve for at least 6 months.
- ✍ The school will get water to use for its kitchen purpose also.

### 4. Ganesh School

The school library room is prepared, for which library furniture was supported by EASL fund. The rooms windows were newly reconstructed to make it secure by placing aluminum windows.
